### **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

The \$2,500 Hilary B. Doran Scholarship, sponsored by the Del Rio Host Lions Club, is a college scholarship for seniors graduating in the spring of each year. To qualify for this scholarship the applicant must be a 2012 graduate of a public or private school in Val Verde County who is scheduled to enter the fall semester of an accredited college or university.

The \$1,000 Lion Jack Dingler Memorial Scholarship, sponsored by the Del Rio Host Lions Club Foundation, Inc, is a scholarship for seniors graduating in the spring. To qualify for this scholarship the applicant must be a 2012 graduate of a public or private school in Val Verde County who is scheduled to enter a recognized vocational or trade school in the fall.

The \$1,000 Lion Allan MacGillivary Scholarship is a scholarship for seniors graduating in the spring of each year. To qualify for these scholarships the applicant must be a 2012 graduate of a public or private school in Val Verde County who is related to a Lions Club member (grandfather, father, grandmother, mother, aunt, uncle, etc) scheduled to enter the fall semester of an accredited college, university, vocational or trade school.

The applicant must provide **INFORMATION FOR EACH SCHOLARSHIP IN WHICH YOU WANT TO BE CONSIDERED** to the scholarship committee the following information:

1. A current copy of their student transcript.
2. A letter of acceptance from an accredited institution.
3. A privacy waiver signed by the student or a parent/guardian if the applicant is under 18 years of age.
4. A **two page HANDWRITTEN** letter. (This letter is extremely important for anyone wishing to receive this scholarship.) The following categories will be scored: need, character, activities, GPA, academic rigor and honors. The GPA and academic rigor can be scored from the transcript. All other category scores will come from the applicant's **HANDWRITTEN** letter.

If a tie exists, the members of the Del Rio Lions Scholarship Committee may interview the top applicants. The selected applicants will be honored by the club with a presentation ceremony. All applicants will receive a letter from the committee after the selections are finalized.

Mailed applications must be post marked by March 31, 2012. **Late submissions will not be opened nor reviewed.**
